Fifty-four bouts were fenced and at the finish it was found that West Point team had tied with Cornell, each having won 18 bouts and were, therefore, each entitled to a place in the big meet. The finals also showed that Yale and Harvard had tied each having won 9 bouts and since one must be eliminated it was decided that Yale and Harvard fence nine more bouts.

## Harvard Winning the Fence.

McLaughlin of Harvard, did the test individual work and won 8 out of Wilbur of the Army and Espandola of Cornell, came next with each, and Roose of Cornell, and received third place of Army, Rayner

with six bouts apiece out of nine fenced.
