

YALE FENCERS LEAD IN TITLE CONTESTS

Get Away to Good Start in Competitions for Team Sabre and Epee Honors

IN THE ASTOR BALLROOM

College Swordsmen Clash Through

10 Strenuous Hours for 7 Cham-

pionships—Finals Today.

Through ten strenuous hours a small army of college swordsmen clashed with sabres, foils and épées at the Hotel Astor yesterday in quest of seven inter-collegiate fencing championships. With an enthusiastic gathering cheering its favorites on to victory, Yale's representatives got away to a good start in the competition for the team sabre and épée championships, and G. J. Wolf of the Blue squad remained in the running for the individual sabre honors. With the foils little progress was made, but Yale's trio was able to win one of its two matches, beating New York University by the score of 8 to 1 and losing to Army, 7 to 2.

The sabre competition, which started in the afternoon, developed into a struggle among Yale, Army and Navy for the team title, and among Wolf and Eskilson of the Navy and Mayo of the Army for the individual crown. The three teams and the three swordsmen apparently outclassed the field and out of their number are expected the championships which will be crowned in the final contest tonight.

Hoffman Hays of Cornell and Lynch of the Army appeared to be the strongest competitors with the foils and are expected to fight it out for the individual championship with that weapon. Hays made a brilliant showing by winning all of his six bouts, while Lynch went through three contests for the individual title and six for his team without a defeat.
