

COLUMBIA, N. Y. U., NAVY, WIN IN FOILS

Each Qualifies With This
Weapon for Finals to Be Held
Here April 2 and 3.

FUERTES STAR OF THE MEET

Ellison, Navy, Also Loses Only One
Bout in Twelve, but That One
Was to the Columbia Man.

ANNAPOLIS, Md., March 20.—Columbia, Naval Academy and New York University qualified in the semi-finals of the Southern division of the Intercollegiate Fencing Association, foils being the only weapon used, held here today, and will enter the finals to take place in New York City, April 2 and 3. Princeton and Pennsylvania, finishing in that order, will drop out of the competition with that weapon.

The competition for first honors between the foilsmen of Columbia and Naval Academy was even in number of bouts won and lost, each winning 26 and losing 10. Individual honors went to Columbia. Fuertes won 11 of his bouts and lost 1, the defeat being by McDill of the Navy. Ellison of the Navy also finished with 11 victories and a single defeat, but individual honors went to Fuertes, the fact that he had defeated Ellison in their bout being the controlling factor.

Columbia clinched its right to individual honors by placing the third man, who won 10 and lost 2. McDill of the Navy, with 9 and 3, was fourth and Jaekel, the star of the Princeton team, was fifth with 8-4.

The three teams which qualified today will meet two teams from each of the Central and Northern division, and there will be a meeting of the same teams for sabre and epee in the same places next Saturday.

The matches today consumed six hours of continuous fencing, two bouts generally going on at once.
