

# COLUMBIA ON TOP IN TITLE FENCING

Sweeps All Three Weapons in  
Qualifying Test for National  
Event at Navy.

## HARVARD AND YALE SCORE

Cornell, Army and N. Y. U. Also  
Register in Tourney—Every  
of Yale Stars.

ANNAPOLIS, Md., March 24.—Columbia was a strong first this afternoon with all weapons in the semi-finals of the Southern Division of the Intercollegiate Fencing Association, taking the leading place with foils, sabres and épée.

The Naval Academy was second with foils and sabres and Princeton was next to Columbia with the épée. The first and second team with each weapon will enter the final of the Intercollegiate Association which takes place in New York City April 5 and 6. The individual contestants in the finals will be the leaders in all three of the semi-finals, the ten highest with the foils and the eight leaders with sabre and épée.

Fencing with the three weapons was spread over seven solid hours this afternoon.

Thompkins, Columbia, and Grant Naval Academy, stood to the front with the foil, the former winning all of his bouts against Princeton and Pennsylvania. However, he lost to both Grant and Wait, Navy. Hailo Pennsylvania started well with this weapon, his left-handed fencing proving a puzzle to his opponents but he tired.

The best match of the afternoon was the foils between Columbia and the Naval Academy. The former took the first five bouts and it looked as if they would overwhelm the Navy, but the latter came back and won the last four. Cohn, Columbia, did the most consistent work with the sabres.

## Yale and Harvard Place.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., March 24.—Yale and Harvard teams qualified in the foils competition for the intercollegiate matches in their tournament in which Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Dartmouth also took part today, Yale winning three matches, Harvard two and M. I. T. one.

Five individual competitors qualified: Captain Every, Yale; Righelmer, Yale; Overstreet, Yale, Getrulo, Dartmouth, and Berliner, Harvard.

Every, intercollegiate foils champion, today lost his first bouts of the season, Captain Getrulo of Dartmouth and Modell of Harvard defeating him.

In the épée contests tonight Yale and Harvard qualified for the team competition, while Hill, Yale; Modell, Harvard, and Miller, Technology, qualified for the individual competition.

In the sabre contests, Yale and Dartmouth qualified for the team competition, while Cetrulo, Dartmouth, was first; Nussbaum and Blossom, Yale, were tied for second and Dennis, Dartmouth was fourth.

## Cornell and Army Score.

WEST POINT, N. Y., March 24.—Fencing teams representing the Army, Cornell, New York University, Ohio State and Hamilton College, competed here today with three weapons in an elimination engagement.

The bouts were semi-finals of the central division of the Intercollegiate League to determine teams and individuals to qualify from that division for entry in the intercollegiate match to be held in New York next month.

Cornell and Army qualified teams in all three weapons, while New York University qualified with one weapon only, the épée. The teams of Ohio State and Hamilton College failed to qualify, but both will send individuals to the meet to compete as a result of today's bouts. Army and Cornell have individuals qualified in all three weapons.

Chardon of Cornell won all his bouts with the foils, his score with that blade being ten victories and no defeats. He was entered in the épée and sabre bouts, but did not fare so well. Lorber was Ohio State's only entry with the foils. He won seven out of ten bouts.

## Hinrichs Best With Epee.

Hinrichs of Army, with five out of six victories, was high man with the épée. Lorber won seven out of eight bouts for the best record with the sabre.
