YALE FENCERS QUALIFY IN ALL THREE WEAPONS

BOSTON, March 16.—The Yale University fencing team placed first in the New England Division of the Intercollegiate Fencing Association at the Boston Athletic Association gym tonight by qualifying in all three weapons, the foils, with 19 points; the epee with 6 and the sabre with 11.

Harvard was second, qualifying in the foils with 17 points and the epee with 5 points. Dartmouth was third by qualifying in the sabre with 6 points. M. I. T. did not qualify. The championships will be held at the Hotel Astor in New York on March 28 and 29.
