

SIX NAVY FENCERS ENTER THE FINALS

Middy Foils and Saber Teams Also Qualify in Intercollegiate Association Events.

ANNAPOLIS, Md., April 5.—The Navy, qualifying its team for the finals with foils and saber and with representatives in the individual championships with those weapons and the épée, took first honors today in the semi-finals of the Southern division of the Intercollegiate Fencing Association.

Columbia also qualified its team for the saber finals, as did Pennsylvania with foils and Princeton with the épée.

The winning teams and individuals will compete in the finals in New York City on April 17 and 18.

The fencers qualifying for individual honors were:

Foils—Howard, Steere and Grant, Navy; Marson and Roth, Columbia.

Saber—Graps and Gulbransen, Columbia; Hains and House, Navy; Hocker, Princeton.

Epée—Marvin and Lobenstein, Princeton; Ellis, Navy; Roth, Columbia; Jones, Ohio State.

In individual competitions the Navy, with six qualifications, was closely pressed by Columbia with five. The latter team, though qualifying two individual fencers with the foils while Penn failed to qualify any, lost the team place to the latter team which had a higher general score.

With all the arms there was some excellent fencing, a feature being the qualification of the whole Navy team, Grant, Howard and Steere, with the foils. Steere is a strong contender for the championship with that weapon.
