

# THREE N. Y. U. TEAMS GAIN FENCING FINAL

Score With the Foils, Saber and  
Epee in Semi-Final in  
West Point Gym.

## DE CAPRILES DISPLAYS SKILL

Army Takes Individual Honors,  
Winning Right to Send 5 Men  
to Hotel Astor Events.

WEST POINT, N. Y., March 21.—The semi-final round of the Central Division, Intercollegiate Fencing League, to select individual swordsmen and teams to meet fencers from the other two divisions, the Northern and Central, at the Hotel Astor in New York on April 2 and 3, was held in the Army gym today.

Cornell, Hamilton, N. Y. U. and Army met on the strips with foils, sabers and épée. N. Y. U. fencers won team honors by qualifying with all three weapons. Army's representatives qualified with the foils and épée and Cornell with the saber.

Army carried off individual honors by qualifying five men in the different events, with N. Y. U. close behind with four.

An interesting feature was the fence-off with the épée, N. Y. U. and Hamilton, tied with one match won and two lost, participating. Army had gained honors with this weapon, 3 to 0. Cornell also had won one and lost two, but was eliminated because its showing in the regular bouts was not considered as good as that of Hamilton and N. Y. U.

The last two named fenced off, the N. Y. U. swordsmen winning, 3 to 1. De Capriles's fine work for N. Y. U. gave his team the victory and the right to enter the finals.
