Princeton's Epee Team Forced To Compete in Six Fence-Offs

In winning three épée team matches yesterday at the Hotel Astor, where the title tournament of the Intercollegiate Fencing Association is being held, Princeton was forced to more than double its regular competitive work.

The Nassau team was involved in six fence-offs, equal to six matches, whereas only five were required in the round-robin tourney. The Tiger swordsmen had two fence-offs before defeating M. I.
