

N.Y.U. SWORDSMEN WIN TITLE IN FOIL

Violets Gain One-Point Lead for Three-Weapon Crown

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., March 13 — New York University swordsmen gained a 1-point lead in a three-way battle for the three-weapon championship tonight at the 73d annual Intercollegiate Fencing Association's tournament.

Trailing Pennsylvania by three victories after the Quakers won the épée title this afternoon, N.Y.U. captured its 19th foil crown as expected for a total of 46 victories in the two weapons.

Navy, which finished second in both weapons, accumulated 45 triumphs, followed by Penn at 44. The three-weapon crown of this two-day tournament at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology will be decided tomorrow with the saber team championship.

Hugo Castello of N.Y.U. and Andre Deladrier of Navy, the coaches, agreed that the saber squads of N.Y.U., Navy and Penn are of nearly the same caliber and that Army, which has the best saber team of the 12 schools in the tourney, could be the spoiler.
