

Penn Fencers Take I.F.A. Team Title

Pennsylvania captured the team title yesterday, but did not fare well in the individual competition, however, as seven Quakers qualified for the individual competition, but none won their weapons. Randy Eggleton, the defending Intercollegiate Fencing Association and National Collegiate Athletic Association champion, in epee, posted a 6 and 2 mark in the individual competition, but had to settle for second place behind James Neale of Princeton, who lost only one of his eight bouts.

Nichlos Benedek of New York University won the saber title with a 6 and 2 showing, as Dave Williams of Rutgers, Bob Pritchard of Yale and Robert Richards of Navy all won five of their eight bouts.

However, it was Mark Smith of M.I.T. who posted the best individual record, sweeping all eight of his foil bouts en route to the individual title. LaSelle Booker of Navy and Jack Tichacek of Pennsylvania both posted 6 and 2 marks in that weapon.
