

N.Y.U. and Notre Dame Gain in N.C.A.A. Fencing

KENOSHA, Wis., March 16—Notre Dame, the defending champion, and New York University, the 1977 runner-up, qualified in all three weapons today at the 34th National Collegiate Athletic Association fencing championships, which were held at the University of Wisconsin at Parkside.

A total of 120 fencers representing 54 schools competed. The preliminary rounds reduced the 40-man field in each of three weapons to 24. The top 24 in foil, épée and saber will compete in a round-robin tomorrow and Saturday to determine the individual and team champion.
