Wayne State Retains 'N.C.A.A. Fencing Title

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa., March 15— Wayne State, with 111 points, retained the National Collegiate fencing title today at Penn State. Pennsylvania was runner-up for the second time in three years and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology was third.

Ernie Simon of Wayne State regained the foil title he won in 1978 by posting a 22-1 mark in the finals. Andy Bonk of Notre Dame, the defending champion, placed second and Alex Florn of George

Mason was third, both at 20-3.

Gil Pezza of Wayne State, runner-up in the epee last year, captured that event with a 21-2 record. Vladimir Zlobinsky of Columbia was second at 18-5. Paul Friedberg of Penn won the saber title with 21-2.
